




## Shoreside Shakespeare

**TO SEP 23** Every summer, the distinctive red-and-white tents of Bard on the Beach (page 76) spring up in seaside Vanier Park, signalling another year of imaginative interpretations of William Shakespeare's timeless plays. This year's line-up includes four of his finest. On the main stage, *Much Ado About Nothing* (pictured) turns Beatrice and Benedick into movie stars in 1959 Italy, while *The Winter's Tale* includes history's most famous stage direction: "Exit, pursued by a bear." On the second stage, *The Merchant of Venice* is updated to modern-day Venice, and *The Two Gentlemen of Verona* features a new four-legged star in the making: Gertie the basset hound in the scene-stealing role of Crab the dog.
