

Who can resist the cute creations from Bamboletta? A labour of love for owner Christina Platt, who moved to Vancouver last year, along with her team of more than 35 women who work from home on Vancouver Island, the small company handcrafts each one-of-a-kind doll using high-quality natural fabrics that are sourced locally as much as possible. Stuffed with local wool, the dolls sport colourful hair made from raw yarns that are hand-dyed and hand-spun. Despite price tags of up to \$375, Bamboletta dolls have become so popular that they often sell out within minutes. Don't fret: new ones appear on the website every Friday at noon, plus at random times on Mondays and Wednesdays.
