

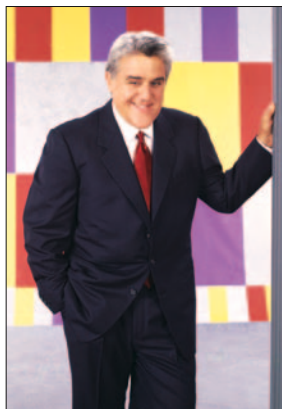


## Horror & Hilarity
