

The Grizzlies of Grouse Mountain: The True Adventures of Coola and Grinder by Shelley Hrdlitschka and Rae Schidlo (Heritage House): Coola and Grinder may be fearsome predators, but they're also North Vancouver's most popular (and furriest) celebrities. Orphaned as cubs, the two grizzlies were brought to the wildlife refuge at Grouse Mountain (page 69) in 2001. This children's book was written and illustrated by a trio of locals who are as enchanted by the ursine duo as the throngs of summertime visitors are.
