



Mapes (Roaring Brook Press): Fuzzy-faced Rialto has been enchanting folks from around the world ever since he was rescued as a tiny, sickly pup back in 2016. This new picture book, which documents his recovery, is filled with photos that solidify his reputation as the world's cutest sea otter. Death Threat by Vivek Shraya (Arsenal Pulp Press): In 2017 a stranger began harassing Shraya, a Canadian poet and musician, by sending her transphobic hate mail online. Using satire and surrealism, this comic book brings to life the vitriolic letters and Shraya's responses to them, showing her emotional turmoil and ultimate bravery. We All Fall Down by Daniel Kalla (Simon & Schuster): As an emergency room doctor in Vancouver, Kalla knows a thing or two about disease. His earlier thrillers explored topics such as superbugs and DNA evidence. In his latest pageturner, an infectious-diseases expert is summoned to examine a patient. The diagnosis? Black Plague, possibly the result of bioterrorism. It's a riveting race against the clock to discover the truth and prevent millions of deaths.
