TRANSPORTATION Buses

WHISTLER TRANSIT SYSTEM Bus routes in Whistler Village and the surrounding areas. Board buses at the front and have exact change ready; exit by rear doors. Aside from service animals. all pets must travel in carriers. Pre-paid bus passes are available—payable by the day, month or trip—from vendors such as the Whistler Visitor Centre or the grocery store in the village. Buses are equipped with bike racks. Hours change seasonally, so check website for up-to-date information and alerts. \$2.50, under 5 free.
